

How Do Catholics Measure a Culture of Life?

- The infant mortality rate increased in 2002, the first increase in 40 years.
- Over 44 million Americans lack health insurance, a 10% increase from four years ago.
- Almost 36 million Americans live in poverty, an increase of 4.3 million from four years ago.
- Abortion rates have increased since the end of 2000, reversing a steady decline during the 1990s. About 50,000 more abortions occurred in 2002 than expected by pre-2000 standards.
- More than 13,000 civilians and 1,100 of our troops have died in an Iraq war called a 'moral failure' by the Vatican.
